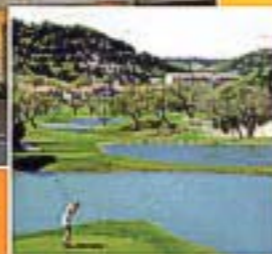
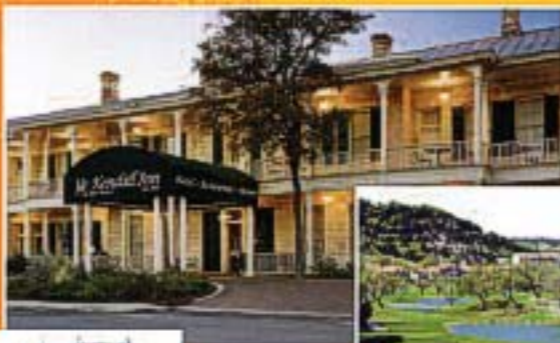

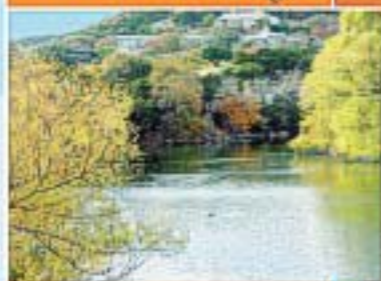
## Need A Place To Stay?

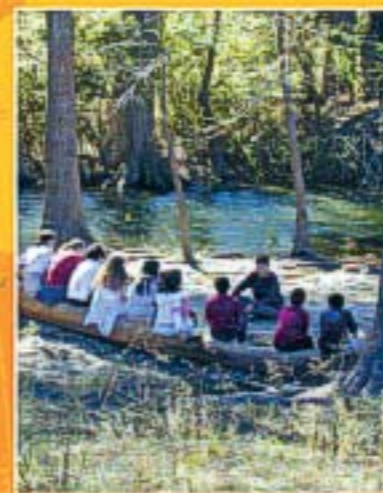


We also have several resorts where you can golf, hunt, tube down the Guadalupe or go horseback riding.

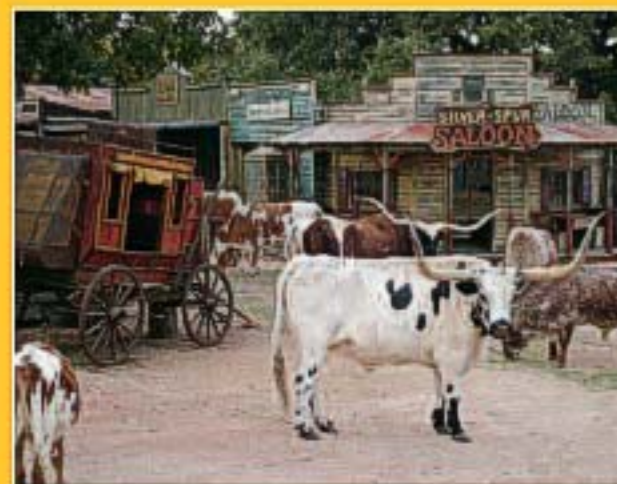

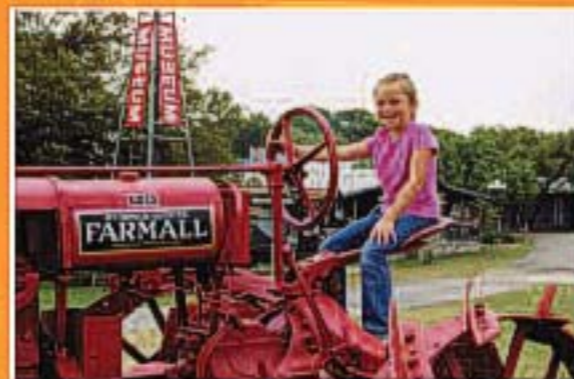
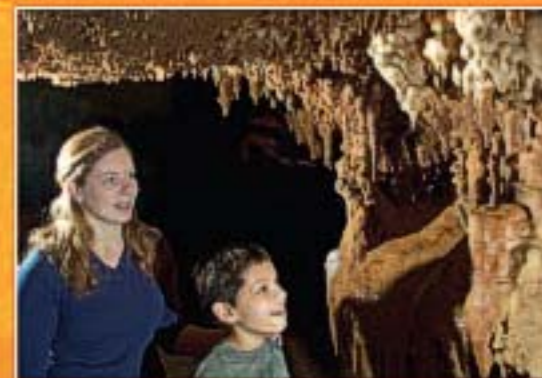
