Attractions and Recreation

Recreation & Tourism

Residents and visitors are encouraged to participate in the community's recreational and tourism activities. Leander's Parks & Recreation Department provides activities for kids of all ages. Whether it is physical programs at the various facilities, Music and Movies in the Park, LibertyFest, Holiday Parade or Senior activities, there is something for everyone in Leander. In addition to this effort, the community's interest in classic, vintage, antique and exotic automotive enthusiasts has brought thousands of participants each month to Old Town. The Leander Car Show is held the last Sunday of each month.

- Benbrook Ranch Park, 1100 Halsey Drive (47 acres) Benbrook Ranch Park has soccer and softball fields, group pavilion, hike and bike trails, a BMX track, skate park, playscape, a disc golf course and restrooms. Benbrook Ranch Park is located within the Benbrook Ranch subdivision.
- Chrystal Falls Golf Club, 3400 Crystal Falls Parkway, www.crystalfallsgolf.com [1], (512) 259-5855. This 18-hole, 6,654 yard par 72 course is the "gem of the Hill Country" challenging golfers of all skill levels. Facilities include driving range, pro shop, snack bar and covered patio.
- Devine Lake Regional Park, 1000 Maple Creek (46 acres) Passive recreation for the outdoor enthusiast. Facilities include a 25-acre lake, pavilion and wooded picnic area, playscape, off-leash pet area, hike and bike trails, fishing and restrooms with 110 parking spaces. Activities allowed: fishing, non-motorized boating and wildlife observation. Trolling motors are not permitted. Access to Devine Lake is within the North Creek subdivision.
- Mason Creek Neighborhood Park, 801 Eagles Way (3.8 acres) Mason Creek Park is a charming neighborhood park nestled in the Mason Creek North subdivision. Amenities include a large playscape, a small trail and a water fountain. There are also picnic tables for small parties and dining in the park.
- Robin Bledsoe Park, 601 S. Bagdad Road (16 acres), Recreational opportunities for the

entire family. Facilities include lighted baseball and soccer fields, playscape, swimming pool, water playscape, pavilion with picnic tables, BBQ grills, concessions, restrooms, basketball court and an amphitheater.

- Texas Stars Hockey Club, 2100 Avenue of the Stars in Cedar Park, TICKETS: 512-GO-STARs- It's not just about the hockey, but fans that are coming from all over Central Texas to see the top minor league affiliate of the Dallas Stars. With an average attendance of well over 5,000, the Texas Stars are making Leander a destination for sports fans in the region.

Other Attractions

- Bagdad Cemetery, Several Civil War veterans can be found in this cemetery established in 1857. It is also in the Hollywood motion picture, ?Texas Chainsaw Massacre.?
- Mason Ranch and Stage Coach House, These historical landmarks on Bagdad Rd. were on the stage line from Austin to Lampasas.
